1	<p><u>Movement in and around school.</u></p> <p>There will be a need to minimise the movement around school for everyone's safety.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - How are you managing minimising movement around school? - Have you considered routes into and out of each classroom or space being used? - Have you considered travel on corridors e.g. single file, one way, markings on the floor? - Have you staggered drop off and collection times, assembly, breaks and lunch times? <p>How are you managing trips to the toilets and for regular hand washing?</p>	Staff Pupils	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All lunchtimes and playtimes are staggered with gaps in between to avoid crossing paths in school. • Entry and exit points are staggered around school to reduce potential chances of pupils crossing in the corridors (see additional plan for further info). • Travel around corridors is 1 way. • Assemblies will take place via webcam and Teams to avoid pupils gathering together. • Pupils are using allocated toilets for the class. These are typically ones that are convenient for their class so mixing should not occur at these points. • Regular cleaning of the toilets throughout the day – see cleaning plan. • Staff can opt in to wearing face masks on corridors if they choose to, however, the corridors present a wide enough space and with staggered times to ensure social distancing is manageable. • Staff are not expected to wear face masks inside school and on corridors.
