

Half Term Curriculum Overview

Year 2 Autumn 1 - 2022

English

- We will be reading the book 'Man on the Moon'. We will write descriptions of aliens. We will build our own space rockets and write instructions on how to make them.
- We will learn how to use information books. We will research L S Lowry and find out about his life. We will write a non-chronological report about his life

History

- We will research the artists Pieter Breugel and L S Lowry and find out about the similarities and differences between them.

Maths

- We will learn about place value. We will order numbers within a 100. We will use equal to, less than and greater than signs.
- We will learn about addition and subtraction. We will learn about fact families, how to add and subtract 10 and how to add and subtract 2 digit numbers.

PE

- We will work outside with Mrs.... on Tuesdays on fundamental movements.
- On Fridays we will create dances to fit with stories in the hall with Mr Strudwick

Science

- We will observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. We will investigate what conditions plants need to grow and stay healthy. We will work in our allotment.

Computing

- We will explore exactly what a computer is by identifying and learning how inputs and outputs work, how computers are used in the wider world and designing our own computerised invention.

Music

Children go on a musical safari; using instruments to represent animals, copying rhythms, learning a traditional African call and response song.

PSHE and RE

- We will find out how to be a good friend and how to resolve arguments between friends. We will look at safe relationships, including online.
- We will explore and talk about different rules using examples in stories and from real life.

Art/DT

- We will investigate colour mixing with Lowry's 5 colours. We will attempt to draw our own matchstick men and we will create a collage in the style of L S Lowry's
