

Half Term Curriculum Overview

Year 2 Autumn 2 - 2022

English

- We will read the book 'Dogger'. We will re-tell the story and use role-play to act out parts of the story. We will relate the story to our own experiences and write our own stories based on losing a special toy.
- We will read the poem 'The Cottage' by Eleanor Farjeon. We will re-write our own version of this with our favourite foods.

PE

Music

- We will learn and rehearse songs for our Christmas Nativity.

History/Geography

- We will research Sir Titus Salt.
- We will consider whether he was significant in Bradford alone or whether he has national significance?

Science

- We will continue with our work on plants. (see last term)
- We will identify and compare a variety of everyday materials.
- We will investigate their uses.
- We will investigate how solid materials can be changed by bending squashing, twisting etc

PSHE and RE

- We will recognise how Christians and Muslims pray and identify similarities and differences between the methods of prayer.
- We will look at how to have safe relationships including managing secrets and resisting pressure.
