

Half Term Curriculum Overview

Year 3 Autumn 1 - 2022

English

- We will be reading 'The Stone Age boy' and writing our own adventure story.
- We will be looking at character and setting descriptions, concentrating on story structure and writing a problem, solution and exciting ending.
- We will be doing A power of reading text based on 'The miraculous journey of Edward Tulane'.
- We will learn how to write a diary entry, predicting what happens next in the story, looking at character's feelings.

PE

- We will be working with Jack from Bradford City on team games.

Music and French

- In Music, we will be listening to examples of Ballads and writing the lyrics for our own.
- In French, we will be looking at French greetings. We will learn how to introduce ourselves and say how we are feeling.

History/Geography

- We will be researching the period of time – The Stone Age to the Iron Age looking at life during this period and comparing each era.

Science

- We will be learning about rocks, soils and fossils. We will describe and compare rocks, make careful observations and look at the difference between natural and man-made rocks. We will learn about the 3 different types of rocks and investigate rock permeability. We will learn about Mary Anning and explain how fossils are formed, as well as

PSHE and RE

- In PSHE, we will be learning about families and friendships- what makes a family and the features of family life. We will be learning about Safe relationships: Personal boundaries, safely responding to others and the impact of hurtful behaviour.
- In R.E. we will be learning about Judaism. We will learn about key

Maths

- **Place Value:** We will learn to: Represent numbers to 1000, recognising all digits in 2 and 3-digit numbers. Placing numbers up to 1000 on a number line. Read, write and recognise numbers to 1000. We will compare and order numbers to 1000. Find 1, 10, 100 more or less than a given number up to 1000. We will count in 50's up to 1000.
- **Addition and Subtraction:** We will be building up to being able to add and subtract 3-digit numbers using standard written methods.

Computing

- We will be learning about Networks and the Internet. We will understand how computers communicate, how they are used to share information and how data is transferred.

Art/DT

- We will create art in the style of the stone age people. Children will explore and experiment different methods creatively using a variety of natural resources
